Rates are for the entire academic year fee period, August 15, 2017 – May 12, 2018 and include a nonrefundable \$30 activity fee and a \$100 security deposit. We offer annual, semester, monthly and financial aid payment plans. All payment plans, with the exception of annual, will add a service fee ranging from \$10 - \$40.

Four meal plans are offered--Green, Gold, Humboldt, and Mini. These plans are explained in detail on the reverse side.

*A resident living in Redwood, Sunset, Cypress, Canyon or Creekview Suites must purchase one of the following meals plans: Green, Gold or Humboldt. Creekview Apartments residents must purchase one of the following meal plans: Mini, Green, Gold, or Humboldt. The table above gives you the combined room and board price for each meal plan and room type.

Dining On-Campus Meal Plans

Students who purchase a meal plan receive “J” Points. The amount of points depends upon the plan you select. Food items are purchased using “J” Points which are electronically deducted from your account. It is an a la carte declining balance point system as opposed to an “all you can eat” system. You are charged only for the items you select and not for missed meals. The declining balance system offers a wider variety of food items to select from, allows a higher quality of food, and offers the convenience of being able to take items to go. Additionally, with a declining balance system, light eaters do not subsidize heavy eaters.

“J” Points may be redeemed at any of the dining service locations. The residence hall cafeteria is similar to a co-op in that each resident pays the same share of the fixed operating costs. Fixed operating costs consist of staff wages, benefits, supplies, rent, insurance, utilities, paper products, office costs, cleaning supplies, etc. The fixed operating costs fund operating The “J.” As a result, all items in The “J” are priced with fixed costs taken into consideration, and therefore are the best value for spending your “J” Points. In order to provide the widest variety of options, “J” Points may also be used in all of our other dining locations. These include the *Giant’s Cupboard*, *Depot*, *Hilltop Marketplace*, *Library Café*, *Windows Café* and *College Creek Marketplace*. Items at these locations will be listed at the cash price and you will receive a 25% discount when you use your “J” Points.

Plan	Description	“J” Points	Cost
Green	This plan is designed for the student with a small to average appetite, or who may eat off-campus and at home on weekends. This student typically skips breakfast, eats a light lunch and an average dinner.	199,200	\$4,704
Gold	This plan is designed for the student who eats a light breakfast and lunch and a moderate dinner.	283,200	\$5,544
Humboldt	This plan is for the student that eats a moderate breakfast, lunch and dinner or who might frequent the residence hall convenience store.	373,400	\$6,446
Mini	This plan is available only for those students who live in Creekview Apts, College Creek and the Campus Apartments. Students living in these areas have access to kitchen facilities and may not wish to prepare all of their meals. No extra “J” Points can be added to this plan.	85,200	\$2,032

Please take into consideration that students with large appetites or those who eat high priced entrées on a regular basis or frequent the residence hall convenience store may need to purchase additional “J” Points during the year, regardless of the plan selected. Extra “J” Points can be purchased for a penny per “J” Point for any of the plans except the Mini.

Dining Facilities

The residence hall cafeteria, *The “J”*, features a choice of three entrées per meal (one vegetarian), a build-your-own sandwich bar, salad bar, a variety of beverages, snack items, and assorted fruits and desserts. Design your own breakfast using our make-your-own grill, waffle iron, and toaster. *“J” Grill*, a demonstration cooking facility located in The “J”, offers fresh cooked hamburgers, fries, meatless options and more. *Giant’s Cupboard*, a convenient on-campus mini-grocery store, carries a variety of snacks and vegetarian foods, locally made items, toiletries, and school supplies. The *Depot*, our food court, offers a variety of flavors and prices. Some examples include hamburgers, fries, pizza, hot pockets, sandwiches made-to-order, local bagels, muffins, cookies, salad & fruit bar, made-to-order smoothies, and Muddy Waters Coffee and Espresso. The *Library Café* is a wireless internet coffee bar offering light snacks, coffee, and espresso drinks. The *Hilltop Marketplace* offers snacks as well as a variety of locally made food items, plus toiletries and school supplies for the student’s convenience. *Windows Café* is our sit-down restaurant with fresh made entrees featuring local products; *College Creek Marketplace* offers a mini grocery store plus pizza, rotisserie chicken, sandwiches, burgers, fresh local baked goods, and a coffee bar. All of our locations offer wireless internet access.
