Faculty/Staff Role

Supporting Research

- Faculty-student interaction has a positive correlation with academic attainment outcomes and promotes educational aspirations (Pascarella & Terenzini, 2005; Astin, 1993)
- Faculty-in-Residence programs create a culture of learning in the residence halls (Sriram, et al., 2011)
- Faculty-in-Residence programs increase student access to faculty (Zellner & Moore, 2011)
- Faculty-in-Residence programs provide faculty with opportunities to enhance teaching practices and gain a better understanding of today's students (Sriram, et al., 2011)

Compensation

- Use of a rent-free, furnished apartment on campus
- Paid utilities, including water, gas, electric, trash, and high speed internet and wireless
- Mini-meal plan
- Reserved parking space (parking permit must be purchased)
- Access to Housing gym
- Compensation may be subject to taxation
