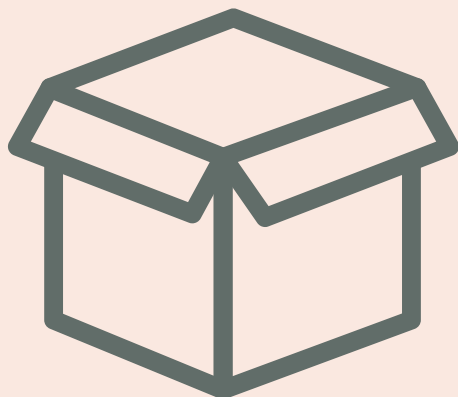

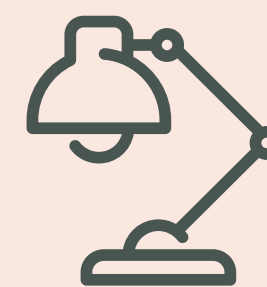

WHAT CAN THEY DO?

Oh SNAP! – A student-driven initiative with services like: a campus food pantry, a weekly stand with free fresh fruits and vegetables, CalFresh application assistance, connections to other local food sources, and outreach events for anyone who needs it.



R.O.S.E. – Offers donated school supplies to students for free to reduce waste and save money. Along with hosting clothing swaps and posting other free items on CampusWall, a university-wide service for swapping, selling, trading, and buying for students.

Bicycle Learning Center – Educates and advocates for safe bicycle use as an affordable, healthful, and sustainable form of transportation and recreation. Teaches bicycle maintenance, operation, and repair for free for students who bring in their bicycles.



Library – Provides students with access to computers and printers on campus. Chromebooks, cameras, and more are also available to rent for special projects!
